3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Mark Our Place Act".

1 **SEC. 2. EXPANSION OF ELIGIBILITY FOR GOVERNMENT-**
2 **FURNISHED HEADSTONE, MARKER, OR ME-**
3 **DALLION FOR MEDAL OF HONOR RECIPI-**
4 **ENTS.**

5 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 2306(d)(5)(C) of title 38,
6 United States Code, is amended—

7 (1) by striking clause (i);

8 (2) in clause (ii), by inserting “(except that
9 subparagraph (B)(i) of such paragraph shall not
10 apply)” after “paragraph (4)”; and

11 (3) by redesignating clauses (ii) and (iii) as
12 clauses (i) and (ii), respectively.

13 (b) **TECHNICAL CORRECTION.**—Section 2306(d)(5)
14 of such title is amended by striking “section 491” both
15 places it appears and inserting “section 2732”.
